

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that a \$200 million, 25-year traditional general obligation bond measure to improve Santa Ana schools will be submitted to the voters of the Santa Ana Unified School District at the Statewide Direct Primary Election on June 3, 2008. A traditional bond requires a 67% voter approval rate to be able to leverage additional State matching funds of \$120 million – bringing the total eligible funds to \$320 million for quality schools.

Notice is further given that the Registrar of Voters has determined that the last day and time for filing arguments for or against the measure is March 10, 2008, 5:00 p.m., at the Registrar of Voters office, 1300-C South Grand Avenue, Santa Ana, California. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. No more than 5 signatures shall appear with any argument for or against the measure. If an argument is signed by more than five persons, the names of only the first five persons signing will be printed pursuant to Elections Code Section 9164, determined in the order in which their signatures for or against the measure is submitted. Preference and priority in the selection of the argument shall be determined pursuant to Section 9166 of the Elections Code.
