<p>February 13, 2012 (E-113)</p>	<p>Resolution calling election to Registrar of Voters. This is not a statutory deadline; however, it helps to have the resolution as soon as possible.</p>
<p>March 9, 2012 (E-88)</p>	<p>Last day to consolidate with Statewide Direct Primary Election. Resolution containing a measure must be to Registrar of Voters by 5:00 p.m. on March 9, 2012. If you wish to have full text printed in the sample ballot, we need to have the full text by March 9, 2012.</p>
<p>March 9, 2012 (E-88)*</p>	<p>Last day for direct arguments, city attorney impartial analysis and fiscal impact statement (if applicable). If your Council passes a resolution prior to March 9, 2012, adjust the date accordingly.</p>
<p>March 10, 2012 through March 19, 2012 (E-87 – 78)</p>	<p>Public Review period for measure text, impartial analysis, direct arguments, and fiscal impact statement, if applicable. Measure documents will be posted on the Registrar of Voters website.</p>
<p>March 12, 2012 (E-85)</p>	<p>Registrar of Voters will email measure letter designations to cities that have measures on the ballot.</p>
<p>March 19, 2012 (E-78)</p>	<p>Last day for rebuttal arguments. If direct arguments are due prior to March 9, 2012, the rebuttals must be filed 10 days after the direct arguments.</p>
<p>March 20, 2012 through March 29, 2012 (E-77 – 68)</p>	<p>Public Review period for rebuttal arguments. All changes due to court action(s) must be finalized by March 29, 2012, 5:00 p.m., to be included in the Registrar of Voters sample ballot pamphlet.</p>
<p>April 26, 2012 (E-40)</p>	<p>Sample ballot pamphlet mailing begins approximately this date. Mailing completed by May 26, 2012.</p>
<p>April 26, 2012 (E-40)</p>	<p>Registrar of Voters will mail a list of polling places within your city. They will also be available on the City Clerk Partnership website. You will be notified when this posting occurs.</p>

May 7, 2012 (E-29)	First day vote-by-mail ballots are available. All vote-by-mail ballots will be issued through the Registrar of Voters. If you receive requests at your City Hall, please forward to Registrar of Voters.
May 21, 2012 (E-15)	Last day to register to vote for the June 5, 2012 Statewide Direct Primary Election.
May 26, 2012 (E-10)	Last day to mail sample ballots.
May 29, 2012 (E-7)	Last day to apply for regular vote-by-mail ballots.
May 29, 2012 (E-7)	Registrar of Voters will mail a CD containing the registered voters within your city.
May 30, 2012 through June 5, 2012 (E-6 - 0)	Emergency vote-by-mail ballots issued at Registrar of Voters office.
June 5, 2012 (E-0)	Election Day. Polls open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
June 6, 2012 (E+1)	Official Canvass begins.
July 3, 2012 (E+28)	Registrar of Voters will certify on or before this date.
