Last day to register to vote in the City of Huntington Beach Special Municipal Election. The Voter Registration Form shall be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the county elections official by this date and effective upon

receipt.

June 10, 2025 (E-0) **CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION PERIOD**: During the period 13 days prior to Election Day and including Election Day, an individual can go to the office of his/her county elections official to conditionally register to vote and vote a provisional ballot.

**SELECT VOTE CENTERS OPEN**: Beginning 10 days before the day of the election, and continuing daily up to Election Day, select Vote Centers are open to the public.

<u>ADDITIONAL VOTE CENTERS OPEN</u>: Beginning 3 days before the day of the election, and continuing daily up to Election Day, all Vote Centers are open to the public.

DEADLINE TO RETURN A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT:

A voter may drop off a voted Vote-By-Mail ballot at a drop box in the City of Huntington Beach, at a Vote Center, or at the Registrar of Voters' drop box or office by June 10, 2025,

8:00 p.m.

**IMPORTANT:** A mailed, voted ballot will count only if the return envelope is signed, dated, and postmarked no later than **Election Day, June 10, 2025** and is received no later than seven days (7) days after **Election Day, June 17, 2025**.

July 4, 2025 (E+24) COMPLETE CANVASS OF OFFICIAL RETURNS AND CERTIFY RESULTS BY THIS DATE: No later than this date, the City Council must declare whether each measure was approved or rejected by voters.
